Wednesday, September 18, 2013 – Accent Film Entertainment is pleased to announce the release of **Static 3D**. A taut excursion into suburban nightmare **Static 3D** premieres on DVD and Blu-ray October 16.

Directed by Todd Levin, **Static 3D** creates unbearable tension as its slowburn pacing and calculated restraint showcases the chops of an up and coming filmmaker to watch. Wringing tension wherever possible from the scenario Levin builds cumulative impact from details while pioneering new technology.

Still grieving for the death of their child, an acclaimed novelist and his wife, hoping to heal their long since disintegrated marriage, answer the door to a distressed young woman who claims she has been followed outside by masked men. Not before long she begins probing the author about his life and it becomes clear something sinister is afoot. What is the husband withholding? Who are the masked men really after?

Static 3D is also a pioneering work of filmmaking being one of the first low-budget features to be shot in full 3D. A camera rig was specifically designed to mount two Sony Pmw-F3 cameras in which to create the illusion of depth.

“The camera work is slow, methodical and beautiful and adds to the often slow and silent moments as the couple try to save their lives and their sanity,” notes the UK Horror Scene. “This highly ambitious first attempt by the former music video maker, was very bold, but when you have as steady a hand as Levin clearly demonstrates,” raves Influx Magazine, “you can afford to take the leap and put your money where your mouth is.”
